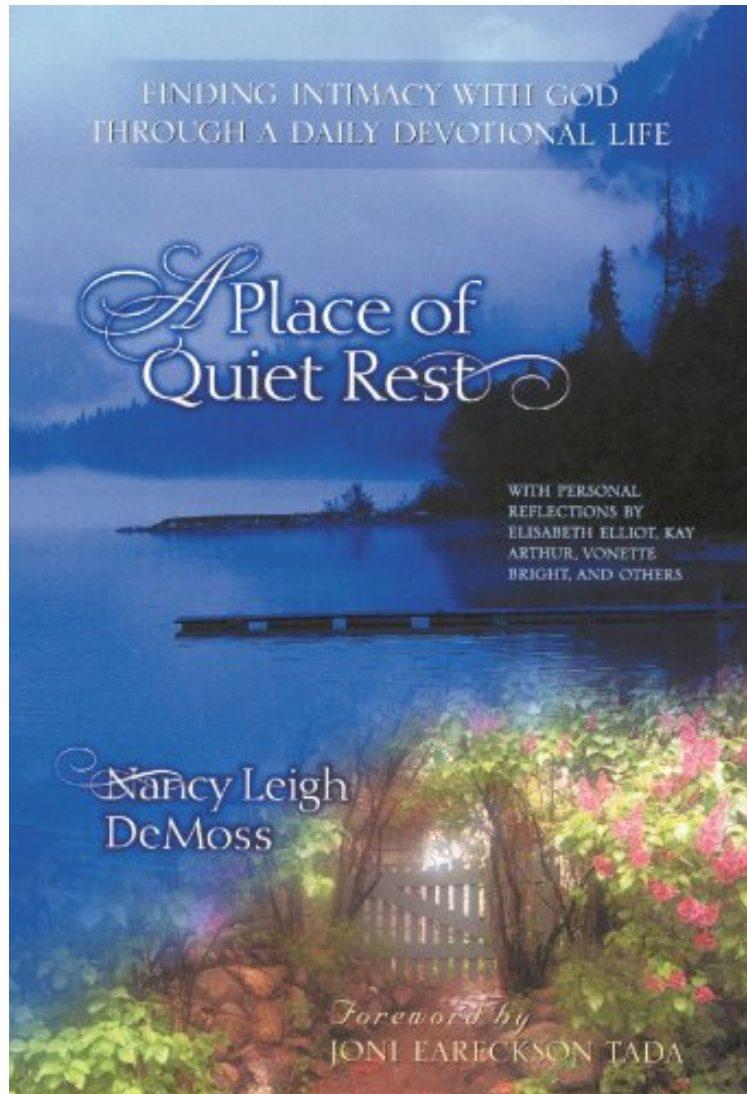

The cover draws you in!Von Soozie4HimOkay, I must confess, I haven't finished this book yet. I've read about 50 pages of it. But I really couldn't wait another day to review this incredible book. The subtitle is "Finding

Intimacy with God Through a Daily Devotional Life". This is not a book of "shoulds" and plans that you have to follow to the letter. Nancy DeMoss's emphasis is that we shouldn't have devotional times to please God (he couldn't love us more already), or to feed proud of ourselves, but to spend time with Jesus Christ, the Lord of our lives! The book is beautifully laid out, from the inviting cover, to the organization of the chapters of the book to an appendix of devotional books (I could add about 3 times as many, though!). The whole book centers on establishing a vibrant devotional life, starting with the priority, the purpose, the pattern, and the problems that come up when we're trying to have a good devotional life. Then Nancy DeMoss has chapters on receiving the Word, responding to His Word. A great feature of this book is that at the end of each chapter, there is a section of questions called "Making It Personal". These questions are just outstanding and get you thinking about what you've just read and you can apply what you've learned to your life immediately. Unlike some other study questions I've run into in other books, these questions do not have an obvious answer and really get you thinking. I find that writing the answers down in a journal helps me a great deal and it will be interesting to look back at the answers in future years. Another great feature of this book is that at the end of each chapter (after the questions section), there is a personal reflection written by other Christian women such as Elisabeth Elliot, Kay Arthur and many others. There are 12 of these vignettes, one for each chapter and they correspond beautifully with the material in the chapter. When I finish this book, I'll write another review! I recommend this book highly! I hope to see other reviews of the book here! Don't you wish you could write authors directly!

The book has been adequately described in detail by other reviewers, but I just wanted to confirm their reports and relate that this is a book that will change your daily devotional time to an activity you cannot live without. Journaling, Bible study, intercession, singing, and other elements of a daily quiet time are covered in detail. Nancy De Moss shares her own failure at times to carve out her time with Jesus and does not set herself up as an example of perfection, but gives us enough tools to help us keep our devotional life vibrant. With notebook and Bible nearby I now thoroughly enjoy my time with the Lord each morning. The book is a great gift but be sure to give one to yourself first. Keep it, and re-read it once a year. It will become a favorite for a "renewal week-end" for yourself once a year.
