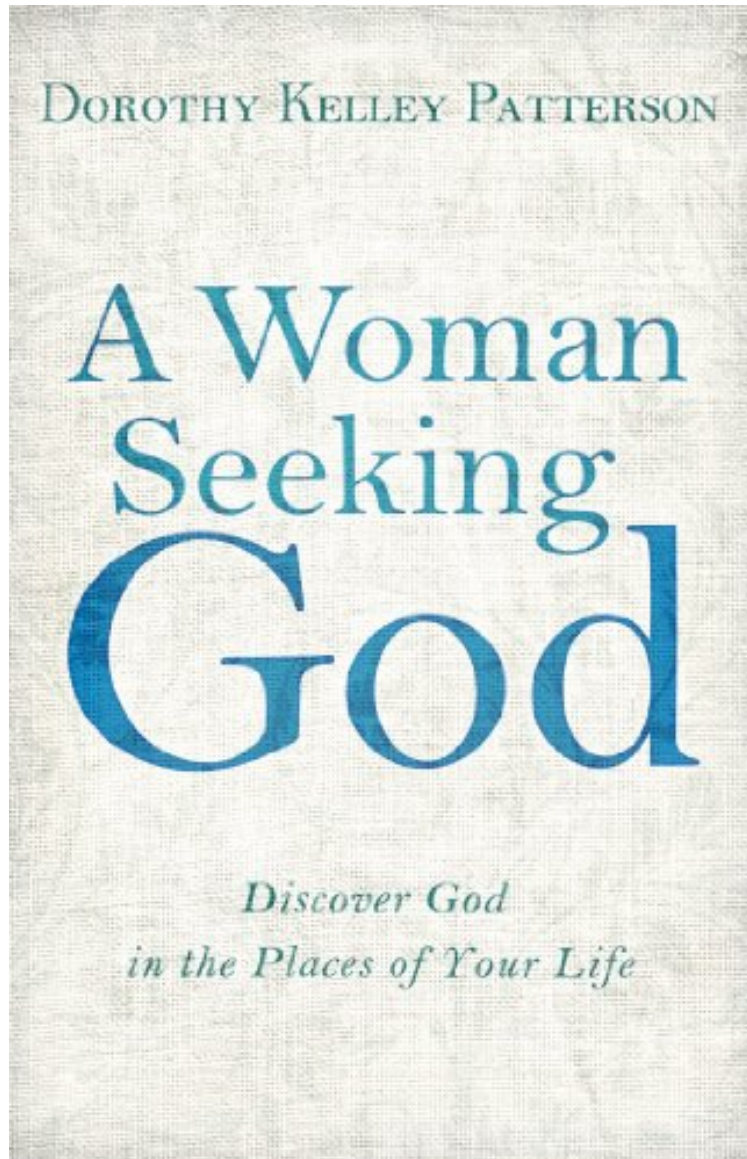

She promotes homemaking as an opportunity for worthy service and source of self-esteem. She says that the wife was created by God to be her husband's helper (Hebrew literally "a help like or corresponding to himself" Genesis 2:18). There is nothing demeaning about being a helper. It is a challenging and rewarding responsibility. God himself assumed that role on many occasions (Psalm 40,17, Hebrews 13,6) This did not mean that the Lord was an inferior but spoke rather of His desire to meet the needs of those whom he loves with an everlasting and unconditional love. Through the ages some have held that women are inferior to men, but the attempt to attribute such an idea to Scripture is unthinkable. She repeats the warning of the prophet Isaiah (Is 3,12) who said that: "Youths oppress my people, women rule over them. O my people, your guides lead you astray; they turn you from the path". Despite the clear positive principles and the precise warnings of consequences for those who ignore or distort God's plan for the home and family, the author states, we find ourselves living in the very "upside-down" world the prophet Isaiah described: "You turn things upside down, as if the potter were thought to be like the clay!"
