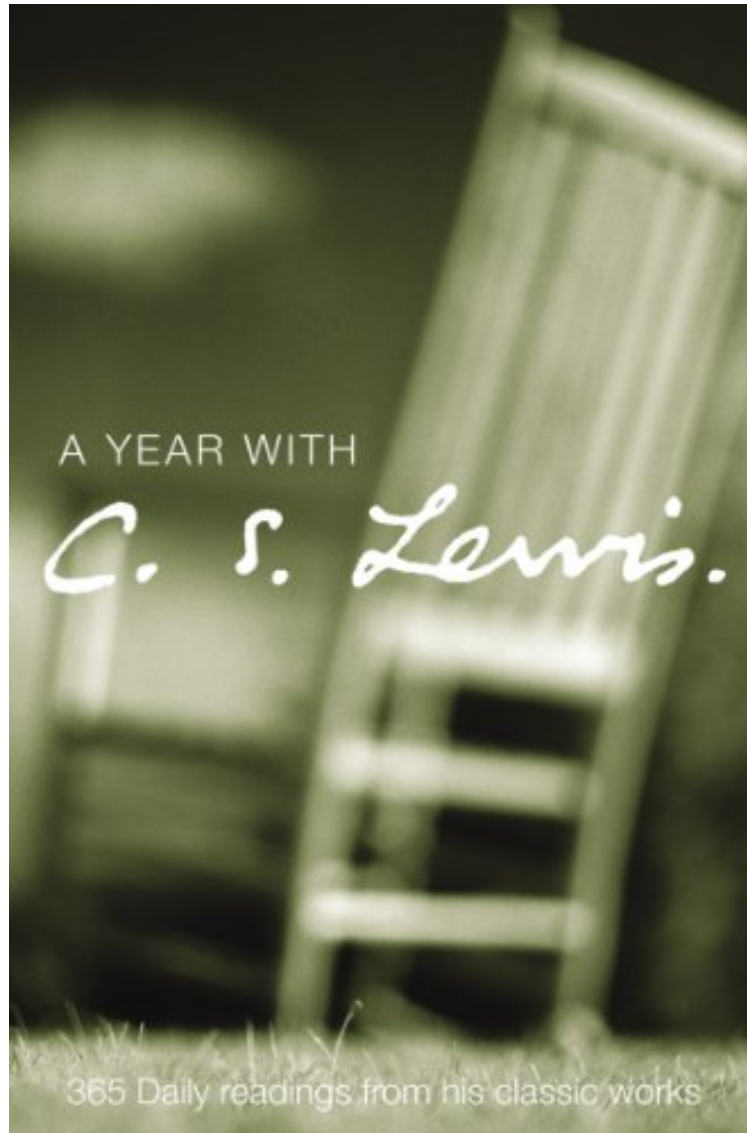

Not Really Paying C.S.Lewis His Dues Von Dave Unfortunately, this book is a lot stiffer and kept more strictly on a theological spin than many a C.S.Lewis fan like myself may have dared to expect from this book. The fact that the vast

majority of C.S. Lewis readers are only familiar with his fictional writings, and not so much his theological ones is left totally unconsidered, and thus, Lewis' entire poetic streak is being dismissed, reducing him to only half the great writer he really was. For a real Lewis fan, inspiring passages from his fictional works are sorely missing from this compilation, passages such as, "Death opens a door out of a little, dark room (that's all the life we have known before it) into a great, real place where the true sun shines... My gold amber house, up there against the sky the greatest King of all was going to build it for me. The sweetest thing in all my life has been the longing to reach the Mountain, to find the place where beauty came from my country, the place where I ought to have been born. Do you think it all meant nothing, all the longing? The longing for home? For indeed it now feels not like going, but like going back. All my life the god of the Mountain has been wooing me. Oh, look up once at least before the end wish me joy. I am going to my lover" (from "Till We Have Faces") to cite only one of many... For those less theologically inclined and in love with the heart of C.S. Lewis the poet, this book is sadly a little bit of a disappointment.
