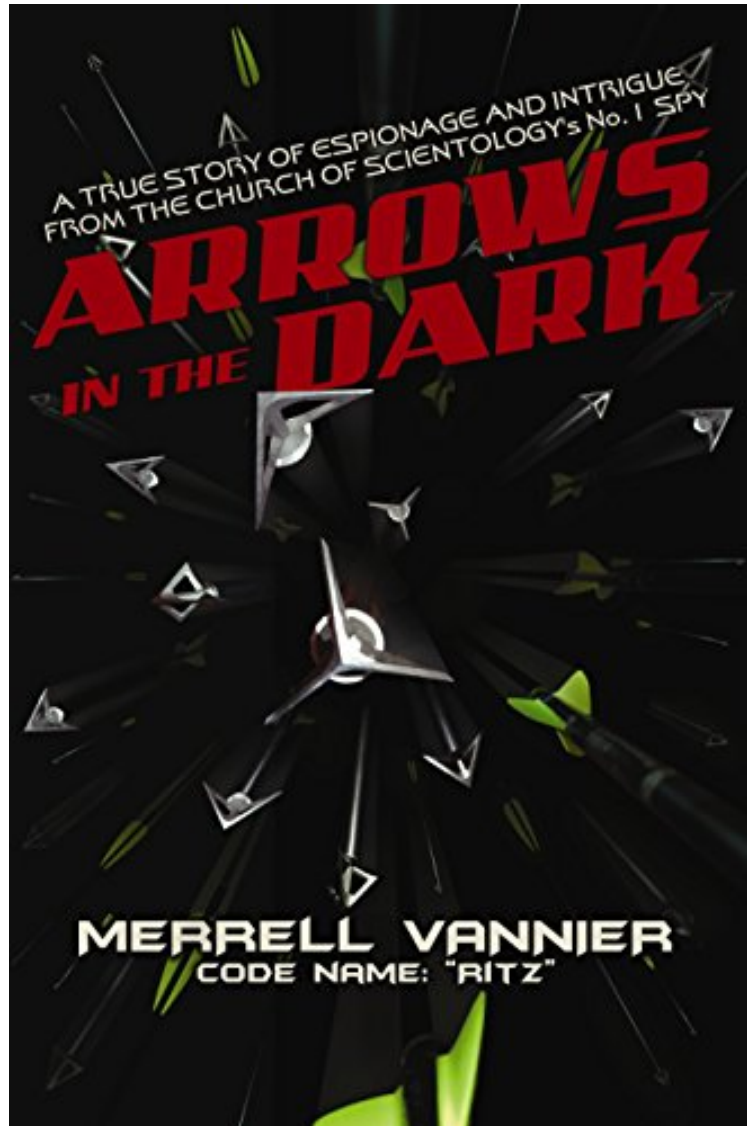

The cover text, including the claim "No. 1 Spy" promised deep insight into the inner workings of Scientology and government authorities who were fighting it.So what is the track record of that top spy? He copied a few documents. He let

someone else into a lawyer's office to copy a few documents. He took notes from a police file. Then he became the lawyer of Gabe Cazares, the Clearwater Mayor, and funneled a bit of information to Scientology. Does that sound like a top spy? Not to me. The juice is in the first 50 pages of the book. The colorful, intriguing character of Don Alverzo pulls off some interesting little operations with a bit of help from the author. The fact that US authorities are not entirely made up of saints (same goes for German authorities) and that governments have their own motives does not come as a big surprise to me. COINTELPRO, often mentioned in the book, has long since been reported about by other people. The rest of the book is the author's personal struggle to keep his lawyer's licence, and some rather mundane back-and-forth with the organization of Scientology. Yet, throughout, the whole thing is extremely well-written, and I finished the book even though nothing groundbreaking happens in the second half. Sadly, the author is forced to disconnect from his daughter. He is critical of the organization, but full of praise for the "tech" of Scientology. Which I can not assess, not having tried it. Yet, there is one story how a Scientology "Assist" process basically cures a friend with severe neurological damages. I have seen weird stuff happen in my life. Maybe it happened that way, maybe not, but my guess would be that at least part of the facts are embellished. A nice read? Yes. Revealing and surprising?
