Nichts desto trotz bekommen wir also einmal mehr die Gründungsmythen von Superman, Wonder Woman, den Teen Titans, Aquaman, dem Flash und eben auch Batman in eigenen Reihen 'neu' erzählt. Und das klappt wirklich gut bei Superman, wo Clark erste Momente und sein Hader mit seiner Bestimmung als Held in Szene gesetzt werden oder für Dianas Geschichte in Wonder Woman. Auch Batman Earth One ist ein guter Comic mit fantastischem Art-Work und viel Emotionen, der das Schicksal des jungen Bruce Wayne und seine Anfänge als Batman toll in Szene setzt, ABER(!): Es passiert nichts annähernd Originelles, was man nicht bereits auch in jüngerer Vergangenheit gelesen hätte (zumal neben den Reboots der New52, in denen die Gründungsmythen erzählt werden, ja auch noch die 'Secret Origins'-Reihe gelaufen ist). Und hier muss man schon fragen, ob eine Geschichte wirklich immer wieder erzählt werden muss. Here it is again the creation-story that plays an important role with Thomas Wayne just set up to become the mayor of Gotham with Oswald Cobblepot as his contestant. But an attack at a botched cinema-visit puts paid to this ambition and Bruce gets raised by Alfred Pennyworth, an old army-buddy of his father. Here not only Alfred gets very reinvented but also James Gordon, his daughter Barbara, Arkham, Crane, Harvey Bullock and some other regulars.
