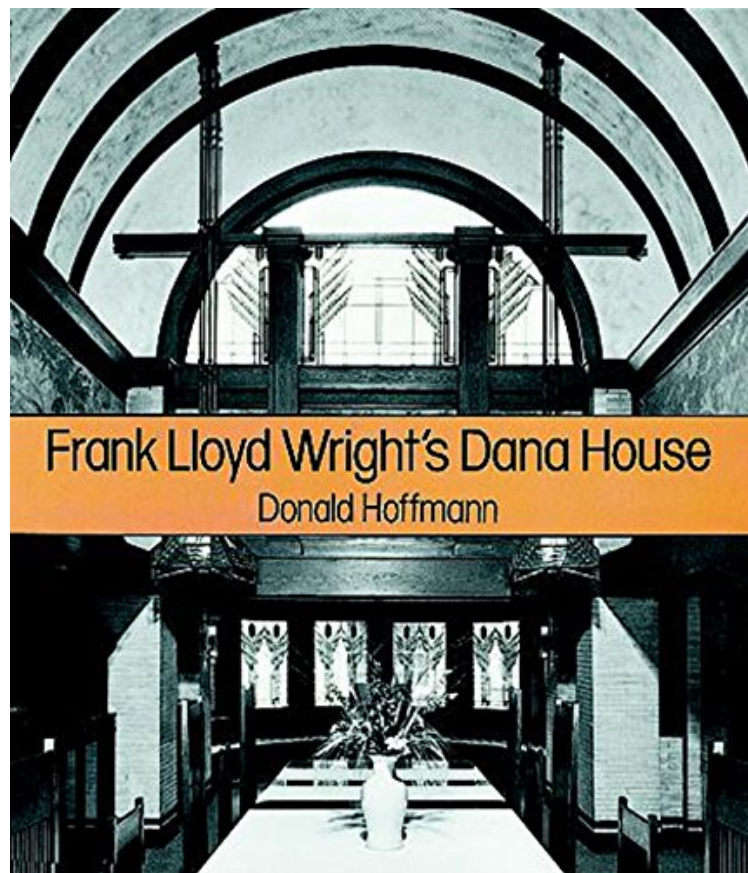

Sie hatte genug Geld und er baute dafür ein sehr großes Haus nach seinen Vorstellungen. Das Haus selbst ist sehr sehenswert einschließlich der Glasfenster und des Inventars. Der Verkäufer hat das Buch zwar sehr schnell verschickt, aber der Postweg hat fast 5 Wochen gedauert - und das ist auch für einen Versand aus den USA heutzutage zu lange! It is a second-hand book, but in a rather good condition. It contains

the building plans as well as a lot of pictures during the construction of the house and after it had been finished. It was built for Dana Thomas in Springfield/Illinois by the famous American architect Frank Lloyd Wright. As she had enough money he designed a very big house according to his ideas. The house itself is very worth seeing including the special glass windows and the furniture and fittings. The seller shipped the book immediately after I had bought it, but it took nearly 5 weeks till I got it. I think that is too long nowadays from the USA to Germany.
