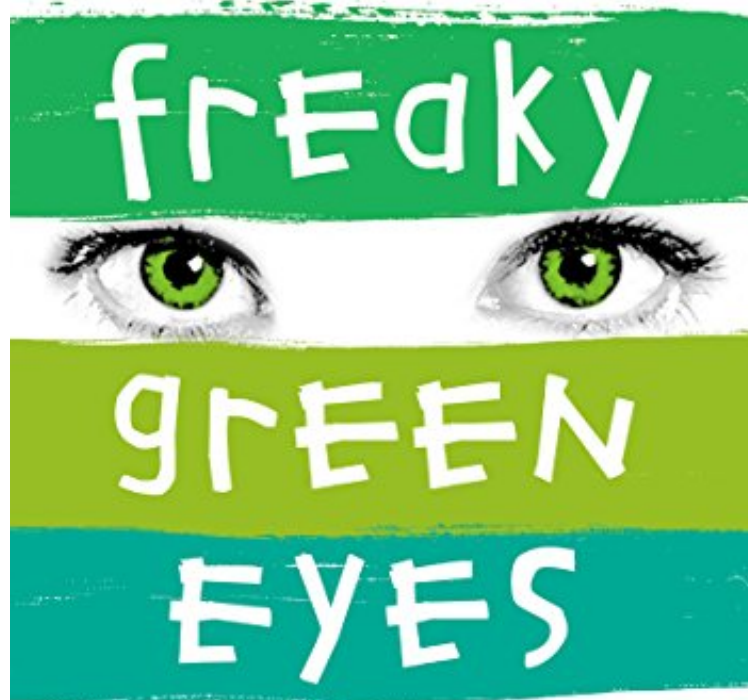

It is an excellent novel and easy to read for young adults, although there are some parts that could have been left out. The author plays with the reader's feelings and lets them sympathize with the protagonist.
