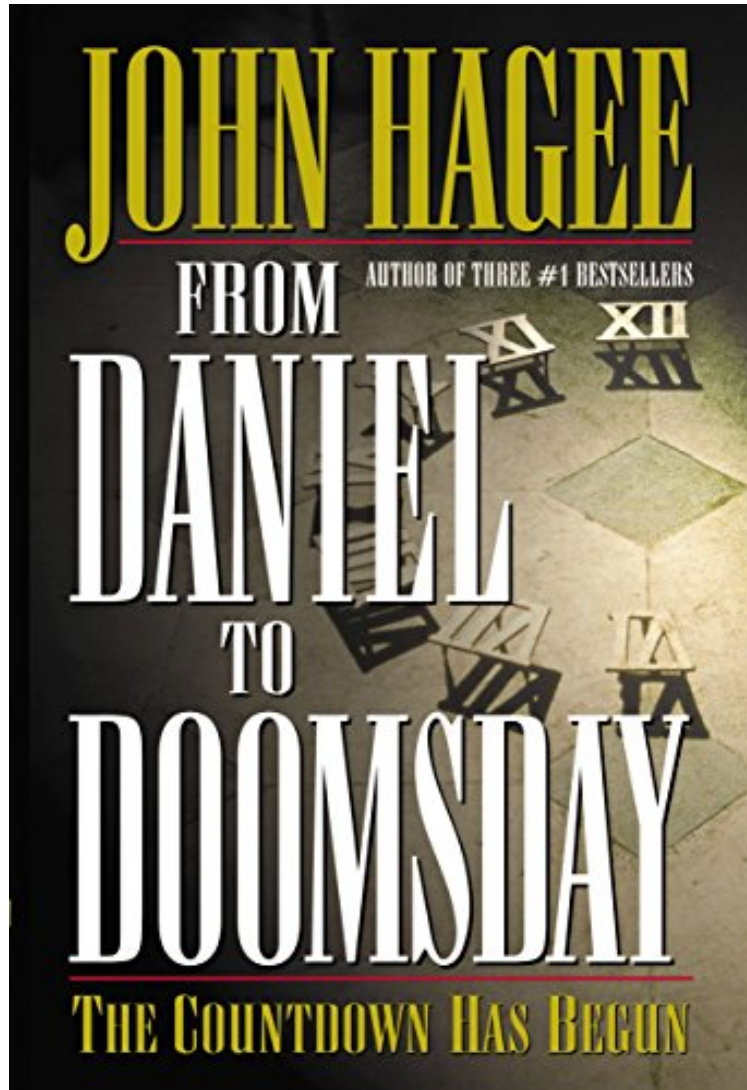

He makes no attempt at all to place the book of Daniel into its proper historical setting. Instead, he conjures up ever sillier end-time scenarios as he tries to shoehorn Daniel into the tired Dispensational interpretation.For example, Hagee spends some time expounding Daniel 7, and tries hard to tell us that the "little horn" is the Antichrist, a future prince of evil who

will rule over the world (at least, according to Hagee). However, he never spends as much time on Daniel 8. Why not? Could it be that Daniel 8 clearly shows that the writer intended the "little horn" to be a Greek, and Antiochus in particular? Similar leaps of logic abound. We are informed that there is a gap between Daniel's 69th and 70th weeks. No attempt at all is made to support this contention from the text. We are asked to believe that Daniel's allegedly precise prophetic vision in ch 11 leaves poor old Antiochus hanging in the middle of his career, and bounces forward in time several thousand years, all the while using exactly the same appellations for the "Antichrist" that Daniel formerly used of Antiochus. Hagee's ignorance of history is profound. A little research would show that Christian interpreters of every generation from the dawn of the age have insisted that they were the last, the generation living in the "time of the end". All pointed to "signs" from their own times that supported their views. All were wrong. If you are really looking for a good commentary on Daniel, in its historical setting, I heartily recommend the book by Hartman and Dilella, part of the very excellent Anchor Bible series.
