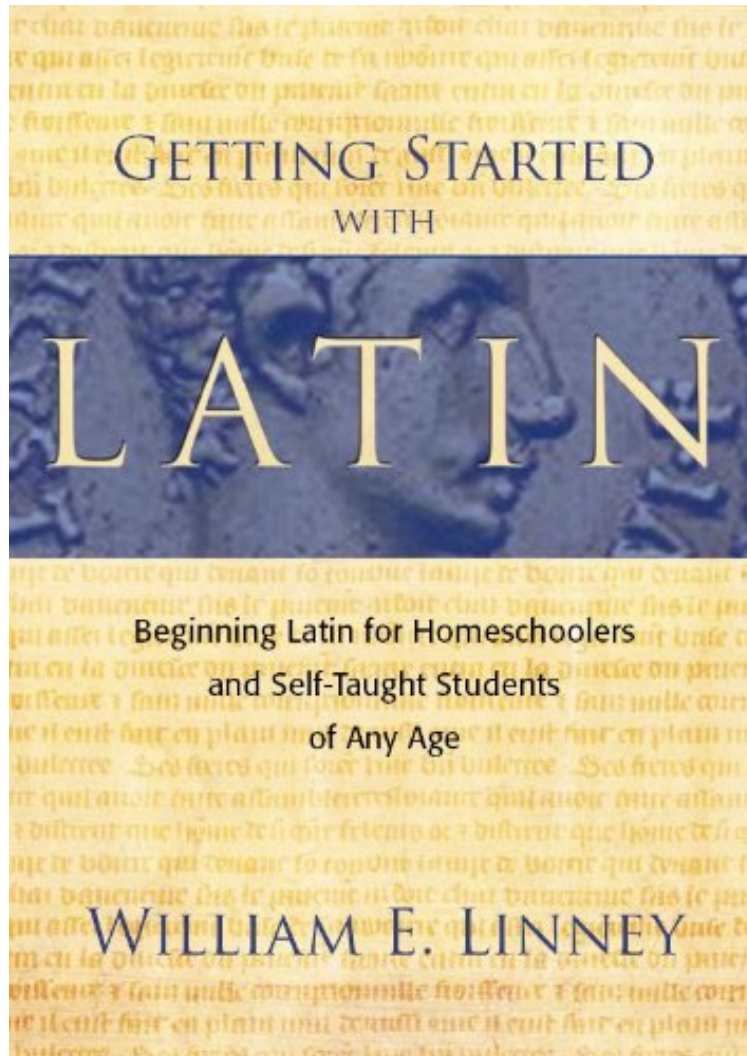

exercises that are intended to increase the awareness of the grammatical concepts in English, an aspect that might be helpful even to homeschooling parents themselves. One example being the role of the "direct object" at the time the "accusative" case is introduced. After that almost all units are followed by 8-12 sentences in Latin for translation into English and allowing to assess the correct understanding of the newly introduced grammatical points. The translations given in the answer section are a good source for the exercise of translating from English to Latin. There is no attempt to build up a story from the sentences and obviously focus on clarity of the concepts. The vocabulary is built up very slowly and at the end covers around 200 words. The sample sentences benefit from it in that the grammatical structures are easier to recognise among words that become gradually more and more familiar as a consequence of this implicit repetition. While that might appear a tad tedious at first you don't need to worry for boring yourself or the student, as the pace can be increased easily in such cases to retain attention. Grammatically, the book covers the first and second declension, the conjugation of the present tense, the infinitive. A first step in Latin and getting started in Latin is done perfectly with this book.

Von Stew This book was made primarily for homeschoolers and for self-study. Linney does a great job at keeping things simple and proceeds logically and methodically throughout the book. He also provides free sound files online to help guide pronunciation, thus helping self-studiers gain an ear for the language. If you have never tried to learn a language before, and if you have no idea what the nominative, accusative, dative, or genitive cases are, then this is the right book for you. If you've already had some Latin, then this book will probably be too simple unless you really suck at grammar.
