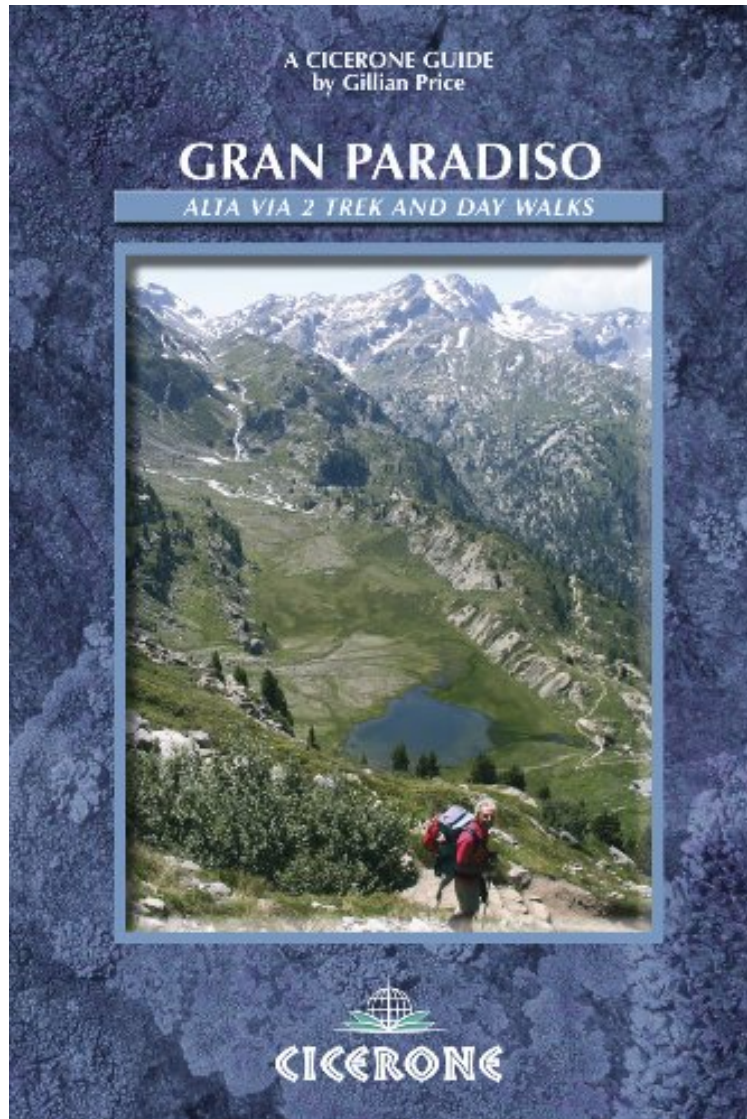

We hiked the whole of it following the southern extension over several high passes with stunning views of Gran Paradiso, Mont Blanc, Monte Rosa and Matterhorn in September / October 2011 under perfect conditions. There was no problem in way-finding and the described route is absolutely feasible for experient walkers (no technical climbing!).
