Von Michael I haven't read Green Arrow Comics before, so I picked this one up to get more information about the Character. After I heard "New York Times Best Seller" and "Fabulous written" I had to see that for myself!----- Story without too much spoils -----First things first: this book is splitted in two main stories, I will try to tell both without spoiling anything important.
