Kurzbeschreibung Sean Daly, the product of strict Irish Catholic ancestry, grew up in the Australian countryside. He is made to believe that the Church's teachings would guide him through life. However, Sean found that many of the people who were deemed to be his role models, even within the Church, lived a life of self-deception and lies. This book looks over the monastery wall for an intimate look into the life of the religious community and touches the sensitive subject of paedophilia in boys' schools. *Living a Lie* is a story of religious beliefs implanted in young minds and maintained by the fear of eternal damnation. It follows Sean through his boyhood indoctrination, his total commitment to the Church and through the onset of doubts about the Church and its teachings. Sean's efforts to leave behind the religious dogmas that formed his conscience and the upbringing that had deprived him of human affection are then explored in this compelling story of religion, fear and hope.
