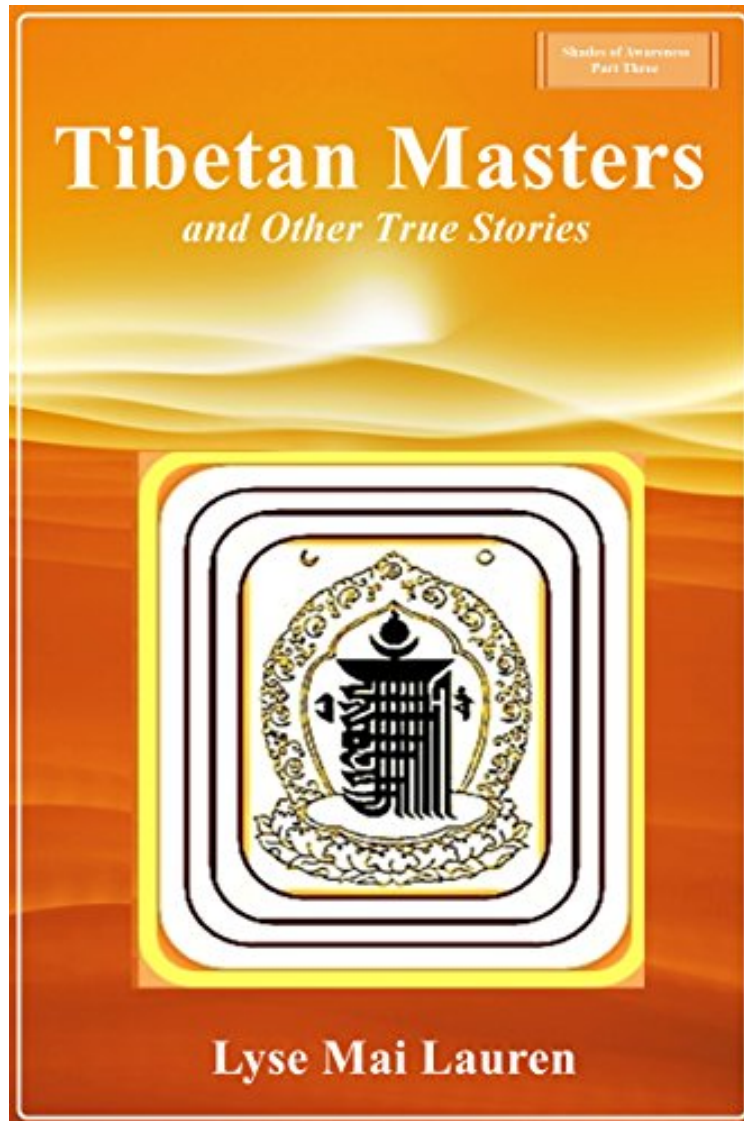

The short stories are well told, personal and she is not showing off. A few of the stories are quite mind-boggling, others tell about more ordinary events, but all of them inspired me and raised questions well worth thinking about.
